ABOUT OUR GARDEN SUPERVISORS

Each season we hire Garden Supervisor positions – individuals who work with the Garden Manager to help lead efforts in the garden and oversee our teams of Garden Engineers.

Garden Supervisors are not direct supervisors to employees, but more so act as a “shift supervisor” while working. Tasks generally include leading teams of Garden Engineers with planting, weeding, harvesting, washing, and packing produce. Additionally, they may be asked to supervise stations at Farmers Markets and/or CSA pick-up locations.

BELOW ARE SOME KEY DETAILS LEADING INTO THE 2023 SEASON

- Garden Supervisors must be at least 17 years old prior to beginning work on the farm.
- Garden Supervisors work 20-35 hours per week and shifts are generally flexible on weekdays between 7:00am – 6:00pm, with the minimum commitment of 9:00am – 12:00pm on weekdays.
- Garden Supervisor positions are available during the growing season between mid-May through mid-October. We understand that with school schedules, students/teachers in Garden Supervisor positions may need to be adjusted in May, September, and October.
- In addition to an hourly wage, our Garden Supervisors receive unique employment benefits such as free produce, skill development, team bonding, and most importantly, a community of people supporting them and praying for them.
- Garden Supervisors will go through a traditional interview process prior to hire and also a background check prior to their first shift.
